SIERRA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PUBLIC WORKS, ROADS & SOLID WASTE STANDING COMMITTEE MEETING

April 14, 2016

The Sierra County Board of Supervisors Public Works, Roads & Solid Waste Standing Committee will meet in session on Thursday, April 14, 2016 at 2:00 p.m., at the Sierraville School, Sierraville, CA. All interested persons are invited to attend.

The following items will be discussed:

SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL

- 1) Discussion on option to charge for solid waste services on National Forest Lands.
- 2) Discussion and direction on community clean-up events that will be proposed for Sierraville & Calpine.
- 3) Discussion and recommendations on Revised Permit Application Submittal to CalRecycle and LEA.
- 4) Discussion and recommendations on Final Closure Plan Submittal to CVRWQCB, CalRecycle and LEA.
- 5) Discussion of schedule for installation of perimeter LFG Monitoring Network Installation – It was originally anticipated that this work would be completed by July 31, 2015, although it was delayed since the property acquisition didn't occur until June 2015. The expectation of the LEA and CalRecycle is that this work be completed this summer.
- 6) Discussion of CVRWQCB LFG Pilot Study Work – This work is scheduled to start this summer with vent and probe installations completed by August 31st. Monitoring would be performed for a period of one year thereafter at which time a recommendation would be made with respect to a passive or active system.
- 7) Five-Year Regional Agency Integrated Waste Management Plan Review/Siting Element Update – This work has been delayed as it requires that the Local Task Force be reconvened to review whether changes in the County's solid waste program are necessary. The County's Siting Element Plan is in need of revision to the extent that the life of the landfill as originally envisioned in the old Siting Element Plan is no longer accurate.
- 8) Future Solid Waste Disposal Planning – Review of disposal options and status of Intermountain Disposal MRF, planning efforts required to facilitate new agreement to have waste hauled to Delleker and cost of installing a compactor bin at Loyalton Landfill to reduce hauling costs.
- 9) Discussion and recommendation on Solid Waste Task Force membership
