FIREARM POSSESSION PROHIBITION

Federal law (18 U.S.C. § 922 [g][1-9]) prohibits certain individuals from possessing firearms, ammunition, or explosives. The penalty for violating this law is ten years imprisonment and/or a \$250,000 fine. Specifically, section 18 U.S.C. § 922 {g}[3] states 'a person who is an unlawful user of or who is addicted to a controlled substance' is prohibited from possessing firearms, ammunition, or explosives. Although medical marijuana is legal in some instances within the State of California, the Sheriff's Office cannot legally under Federal Law issue a Concealed Weapons Permit to anyone engaged in the use of marijuana for medicinal or recreational purposes. By signing below, you hereby affirm that you do not use marijuana and understand that if you do, your CCW permit is no longer valid and subject to revocation.
