

Sierra County Sheriff's Office applies for grant funding for the Off-Highway Vehicles (OHV) Patrol

The California State Parks' Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division administers a grant program which has provided significant funding to help the Sierra County Sheriff's Office manage off-highway vehicle recreation in Sierra County. The Sierra County Sheriff's Office has completed the 2022 – 2023 Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation grant request. The Sierra County Sheriff's Office current grant request provides for operation and support of public safety and law enforcement efforts for numerous trails and roads located on public lands open to OHV use.

The public review and comment period for the 2022 - 2023 Grant and Cooperative Agreement Program will run from Tuesday, March 8, through Wednesday, May 3, 2023.
